**Message from Mary Anne Malone, Parish Life Coordinator**

On Friday (8/4), we celebrate the feast of St. John Vianney. St. John was born in France in 1786. His formal education was interrupted by the French Revolution and then the Napoleonic Wars. He was finally ordained in 1815 and lived most of his priestly life in the village of Ars. Known as the Curé of Ars, he was devoted to saving souls, spending long hours in the confessional. People came from everywhere to speak with him, and eventually he was counseling 20,000 pilgrims a year. He was devoted to the Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament saying: "How pleasing to Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament is the short quarter of an hour that we steal from our occupations, from something of no use, to come and pray to Him, to visit Him, to console Him. Saint John Vianney, pray for us.
