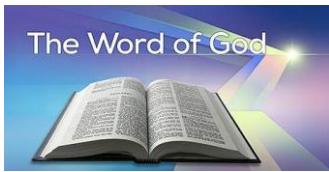
Our children will once again be presenting the Christmas Story during the Christmas Eve Mass at 6 PM.
